### Did you know?

- An important update to Collin College Policy is being considered by the Board of Trustees. The policy, which had its first reading in March 2024, allows faculty to choose to assign a temporary "0" when they submit a student incident report of scholastic dishonesty to the Dean of Students. This will notify students that a report was made and the hope is that the response time to the DOS will be faster. This is due for a second reading soon! When it is approved, make sure to check out the details including the updated information that will be added to the course syllabus.
- If you have ever been asked to speak/travel internationally, you may know that this has historically been limited to once every three years and only with the District President's approval. A policy is due for a first reading this week that would allow the District President to approve international travel without a time constraint. Stay tuned...
- The Faculty Council has worked with administration this year to clarify and update documents defining the Standard Operating Procedures for a number of issues that affect you. These will be posted in CougarWeb for your reference, and will include:
  - Overloads Procedure
  - Faculty Absence Procedure

This widget is available to all faculty, staff and administrators. More documents to ensure everyone is following the same procedures districtwide will be coming soon!

- It is time to begin thinking about your goals for next year! Goals should reflect your intentions in being an excellent faculty member, and should support your future MYC applications. Ideally, you will create three goals each year (teaching, professional development, and college service) that allow you to grow as a professional and support your career development.
  - A teaching goal might be learning more about an area or application of content that you would like to incorporate into your classroom. Alternatively, it might be learning more about a pedagogy of interest to you.
  - A professional development goal to attend a state or national conference will grow your professional circle, expose you to new ways of thinking and teaching, and can be supported by COE funds.
  - A college service goal can be to expand your involvement in ongoing, collaborative service with colleagues in the District, allowing you to contribute your skills and talents and learn from others to benefit Collin.

- Teaching this summer? Summer Office Hours requirements are "one hour per week for each course section taught." (Faculty Handbook)
- Your 2024 Annual Appraisal is available NOW to complete in Workday!
- Reminder: You can now find your MYC status in Workday! No more waiting for an email or wondering if you need to prepare. To check your status:
  - Log in to Workday and click on your picture in the upper right corner.
     Select "View Profile."
  - In the left margin, select "Job."
  - In the center panel (under the "Search" tab), select "Employment Data."
  - Your Contract Status will be listed under the heading "Employee Contract."
  - You are up for a Multi Year Contract application if you are listed as:
    - C12 Second One-Year FT Contract
    - CC12 First COE Contract Year two of three
    - 3YX.2 (CE2) Contract Extension Year two of three
  - You are up for a Contract Extension IF you are listed as:
    - CC2 Second COE Contract Year two of three
