- b. Support for Associate Faculty: Training and mentorship for Associate Faculty is a great area of focus as Collin continues to grow. How can we foster a growth environment for our Associate Faculty? The Faculty Council briefly discussed mentorship, teaching training, SOBI training, conferences for professional presentations, support for a higher awareness of job search expectations, support for properly documenting vita and resume items, and college support and funding for training all as potential ideas. The membership was encouraged by how Dr. Matkin also seemed to be supportive of some ways to encourage Associate Faculty as they do work very diligently for the College.

c. Faculty Compensation Committee

Nick Morgan states that the Faculty Compensation Committee is still a priority. If we have any questions from the Faculty, we will certainly move those forward on the behalf of the membership. The committee member's names are on the web if anyone wishes to look them up. Members discuss that they are concerned about the loss of the 14% Summer pay.

d. Campus Management

Some members of the faculty council would like to see a more cohesive list of procedures across campuses. The lack of some inconsistent processes seems to be an issue for both full-time and part-time Faculty.

e. Personal Days

The committee would like to know more about the use of personal days and how they can be used, when they can be used, what they can be used for and when, and how they cannot be used by faculty. There seems to be different interpretations. Nick Morgan will be working on contacting someone who can clarify the rules for us.
