How It Works

1. **Be prepared** before coming to the math lab. Make sure that you have read your assigned sections and bring your notes.
2. **Please sign in** to the math lab when you enter. You will need your full 9-digit CWID number in order to sign in.
3. **To ask a tutor for help, enter your name in the [Question Queue](#).** You must be present in the math lab in order to use the Question Queue. A link to the queue system is posted on the math lab's website, it can be also accessed by scanning QR code placed on each table in the lab.
4. **Please get ready** before your tutor arrives by reading and attempting the problem. Tutor will not be able to sit with you for extended periods of time.

Although the Math Lab maintains a highly qualified staff that is eager to serve students, there are restrictions on the type of help tutors can offer. What tutors *can* and *cannot* do are briefly outlined in the following table.
